How to use the Book BINGO:

- a. Choose any of the squares that has a book description. Read the description with your child.
- b. Find a book that tells about the description you chose. You can find the book in a library, on the internet or you might already have it.
- c. After reading the book, mark the square with a pencil or circle it then write the title on the Reading Log.
- d. Try to fill in as many of the squares as you can.
- e. Fill out the reaction worksheet with your child.
- f. Bring in the Summer Reading Packet and your favorite book if you have it on the first day of school.
